TITLE: Colorado Springs Chapter Marks 70th Anniversary of Korean War Armistice

The Colorado Springs (COS) Chapter commemorated the 70th Anniversary Armistice ending the Korean War. Companion Councilman Randy Helms read the city proclamation honoring the service members who served and sacrificed during the Korean War. Guest speakers included Canadian Consul General Sylvain Fabi highlighting the 25,000 Canadians who served and 516 who died in the war. Consul General Hyun Chul Kang represented the South Korean people in expressing their gratitude for America's sacrifice. Companion Rich Peters met with members of the local KWV Association (KWVA), Widefield high school Navy JROTC cadets, and local Korean community representatives celebrating the armistice ending hostilities in the "land of the morning calm" on July 27, 1953.
