The Chapter was pleased to welcome Mr. Norman Lieberman, Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Office of Intelligence & Analysis' (I&A) Rocky Mountain Regional Director encompassing CO, ID, MN, MO, NM, ND, SD, UT and WY. Mr. Lieberman's presentation covered 1) an overview

of the DHS mission and TSA's role in supporting the mission through effective management of I&A personnel in the region in planning, collection, processing, analyzing and disseminating intelligence and homeland security information primarily in partnership with State and local fusion centers; 2) intelligence

fusion center operations; and 3) regional threat summary. At the conclusion of his presentation the attendees gained an understanding of the role TSA intelligence in concert with federal, state and local law enforcement agencies working in partnership in securing the nation from the threats faced.

Guest speaker for meeting is COL Dave Brooks, Commander, 1st Space Brigade, U.S. Army Space and Missile Defense Command. COL Brooks is a 1999 graduate of the United States Military Academy



(USMA) where he received a Bachelor of Science Degree and was commissioned in the Field Artillery (FA). He has held leadership positions in FA at platoon and battalion. He had operational deployments to Operation Desert Spring, and Operation Iraqi Freedom I, III, and V as a FA officer.

COL Brooks transitioned from FA to a Space Operations Officer in 2008. He held staff leadership positions at the Joint Navigation Warfare Center (JNWC) and Special Operations Command-US Southern Command (SOCSOUTH).

He commanded the 1st Space Battalion at Fort Carson, Colorado from July 2017 to June 2019. COL Brooks established USSPACECOM's Joint Integrated Space Teams at both USSOCOM and USCENTCOM prior to assuming Command of the 1st Space Brigade.

COL Brooks holds a Bachelor's of Science
Degree in Civil Engineering from the USMA and
a Master's Degree in Earth Remote
Sensing/Hyperspectral Imagery from the Florida
Institute of Technology. His military education
includes numerous US Army, Joint and Space
courses.

His numerous awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with two oak leaf clusters and badges include Combat Action Badge, Army Master Space Badge, and the Air Assault Badge.

COL Brooks is married to the former Patricia (Patti) Laucks. Both consider Ormond Beach, FL as their hometown and have one son, Camden (age 14).
